## About e-mail etiquette – again . . .

The WSN Board is climbing back on its soapbox on the subject of e-mail etiquette.

Unsolicited e-mails are an ongoing problem for anyone with an e-mail address.

If you are sending a mass e-mail, here are a few guidelines. (Note: WSN does not publish or share its e-mail list.)

- When you're sending a message to WSN members or any group of people, enter their addresses in the "Bcc" line to protect everyone's privacy. Enter your own address in

the "To" line. Sending your message to contacts who do not know each other is not only unprofessional, but you are publishing someone else's e-mail address without their permission. This is a privacy issue!

- Include clear and simple unsubscribe information in all your e-mail materials. When there is an unsubscribe request, removal should be immediate.

- Stay educated about e-mail marketing and spam laws. Laws
