# Hypnotism: Journeys of the Mind

WSN's November 7 speaker will be Kathryn McGlynn, a professionally trained Certified Consulting Hypnotist, Motivational Coach, and Emotional Intelligence (EQ) Development Trainer.

Kathryn will be addressing our group on how hypnosis helps change attitudes, which is a key to changing behavior. Her focus will be on creating abundance and determining and setting goals.

A member of the American Holistic Health Association, Kathryn has been in the field of holistic and complementary health care for nearly 30 years. Her work has helped people who have been stuck in some way or have a problem - such as mental and physical tension.

Kathryn's clients come to her in search of a lifestyle change. Many are smokers or are seeking to lose weight. Others are trying for a non-pharmaceutical solution for stress or insomnia, or hope to harness their bodies' ability to heal when coping with cancer or surgery.

Kathryn has been practicing self-hypnosis since the 1970s and took it a step further in 1996 when she received formal training in hypnotizing others. It wasn't until 2001 that it became her full-time career.

## Envision 2020

The Women at Work Museum, located at 35 County Street in Attleboro is celebrating its 4th year in operation with a new exhibit entitled Envision 2020, which is the year women will celebrate their 100th anniversary of the right to vote. The mission of the Museum is to honor the achievements of women throughout history, provide educational programs that promote leadership, economic independence, and expertise in math, science, engineering and technology, and recognize the efforts of individuals and organizations that support equity in education and in the workplace. As part of the exhibit, the Museum is looking for submissions for a photography exhibit of young female up-and-coming leaders, specifically young women ages 13-30 who are making a difference in their community, school, workplace or place of worship.
